
It Sounds Along the Ages

Jewish, Christian, Buddhist, humanist, and Transcendentalist stories in this hymn:

[&]quot;the psalmist" — the anonymous author(s) of the psalms of the Hebrew Bible

[&]quot;From Sinai's cliffs" — where Moses stood when leading his people to freedom

[&]quot;Buddha's tree" — the Bo-tree under which Gautama Buddha achieved enlightenment

[&]quot;Athen's market" — where the philosopher Socrates taught his humanist philosophy

[&]quot;Galilee" — the region of Judea where Jesus of Nazareth begn his teaching

[&]quot;hammer stroke of Luther" — Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses to public view, the start of the Protestant Reformation

[&]quot;oracles of Concord" — Transcendentalist authors Emerson, Thoreau, and Alcott, who lived in Concord, Massachusetts
